ORDER

This matter was last heard on 15.11.2022

In this matter the complainant booked a flat in the project PG Town in 2016 and had paid Rs. 15,00,000/- out of the total consideration of Rs. 17,00,000/-. The complainants have filed the complaint case as the respondent failed to construct the project. The complaints have been filed for refund of the paid consideration along with interest.

The complainant has placed on record copy of M.O.U. dated 01/11/2016

Perused the records. No reply has been filed by the respondent.

On the last date of hearing, the complainant reiterated his prayer for refund.

The Bench notes that despite several opportunities the respondent failed to appear before the Bench, so, orders are being passed on the basis of documents available on the record.

The Authority observes that the allottee has not sent any communication to the promoter regarding cancellation of booking. The Authority ought to be approached only

after the promoter fails to respond to such communication. However, since the matter has already been heard, and the promoter is not appearing, orders are being pronounced.

After considering the documents filed and submission made, the Bench hereby directs the respondent company and its Directors to refund the principal amount of Rs. 15,00,000/- to the complainant along with interest at the rate of marginal cost of fund-based lending rate (MCLR) of State bank of India as applicable for three years plus 2% from the date of taking booking till the date of refund within sixty days of issue of this order.

With these directions and observations, the matter is disposed of.
