Hearing taken up. Mr. Rajeev Kumar, husband of complainant is present with authority. Respondent is absent.

Mr. Rajeev Kumar, husband of complainant reiterates the order passed in complaint case for refund with interest and non compliance of the same till date. He further submits an application to send requisition to District Magistrate under section 40(1) of the RERA Act, 2016, read with Rule 26 of the Bihar RERA Rules, 2017.

The Bench notes the submission of learned counsel for complainant and observes despite notice, the respondent failed to appear before the Bench and has not complied the direction of the Authority till date. Hence, considering the prayer of learned counsel for complainant to proceed under section 40(1) of the RERA Act, 2016, read with Rule 25 of the Bihar RERA Rules, 2017, the Bench directs to send a requisition to the District Magistrate, Patna for recovery of the amount due along with interest as per the order passed in complaint case under section 4 & 5 of Bihar and Orissa Public

Demand Recovery Act, 1914, under section 40(1) of RERA Act, read with Rule 25 of the Bihar RERA Rules.

With these aforesaid observations and direction, this execution petition is disposed of.
