ORDER

18-02-2022 The matter was last heard on 14-01-2022.

The complainant had filed a complaint petition under section 31 of the Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Act, 2016, in November, 2018 against M/s DPM Infrastructure & Housing Pvt. Ltd for the refund of the principal amount with interest as the promoter has fail to honour the terms of the agreement.

The complainant, in this Execution Petition filed on 04/03/2021 has submitted that final order dt.31-12-2020 was passed directing the respondent to payback the full amount of deposit along with the interest rate of (MCLR) of the State Bank of India plus two percent from the date of deposit to the date of refund to the complainant by respondent company.

During the last hearing on 14-01-2022, Complainant had submitted that the respondent has not complied with the order dated 31.12.2020 and has not refunded the said amount i.e. Rs. 25 lakhs (as per the order) as yet.

No one has appeared on the behalf of the respondent company.

The Bench notes that the respondent company was given ample opportunity to comply with the final order dated 31-12-2020 but has failed to do so. Therefore, a token penalty of Rs.1 lakh (one lakh only) is imposed upon the respondent company to be paid within 15 days from the date of order.

On the basis of the submissions and taking into consideration the documents filed, it is found that as on date, no order has been shown which stays the order passed by the Authority on 31.12.2020. Under these circumstances,

the respondent company is hereby directed to comply with the order passed in the complaint case on 31-12-2020 within 15 days from the issuance of this order. In case of failure to comply with the order within the stipulated time frame, recovery certificate under P.D.R. Act and criminal complaint case as per provision of the RERA Act, 2016 will be instituted against the respondent company and their directors.
