## **ORDER**

Hearing taken up under section 5 (1) (b) of the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Act, 2016, for rejection of the application for registration of the project 'CRYSTAL CITY'.

Real Estate Regulatory Authority, Bihar issued a show-cause notice to Wishluv Buildcon Private Limited, through its Director, Mr. Lav Kush Sharma, on 03.03.2022 as to why the application for registration of the Project CRYSTAL CITY, filed by the company with the Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA), Bihar, on 04.01.2022, should not be rejected under Section 5 (1) (b) of the Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Act, 2016. The grounds for rejection were that the applicant failed to furnish map duly approved by the competent Authority as the map enclosed with the application was approved by Mukhiya-Gram Panchayat Raj, Dariyapur, Naubatpur, Patna whereas the location of the project falls within the Patna Metropolitan Area Authority.

Learned Counsel Sharad Shekhar appears on behalf of the respondent company and seeks time to submit a revalidated map from the competent authority. The Bench suggests the promoter to withdraw the application for registration of the project as the map submitted has not been approved by the competent authority. The learned counsel agrees to withdraw the application for registration

but liberty may be given to submit the application again with the map as approved by the competent authority- Patna Metropolitan Area Authority.

The Bench allows the prayer of the promoter to withdraw the application for registration of the real estate project 'CRYSTAL CITY' with the liberty that promoter may apply again for the registration of same project in future after obtaining approval of the map from the competent authority along with requisite documents and no fees would be charged.
